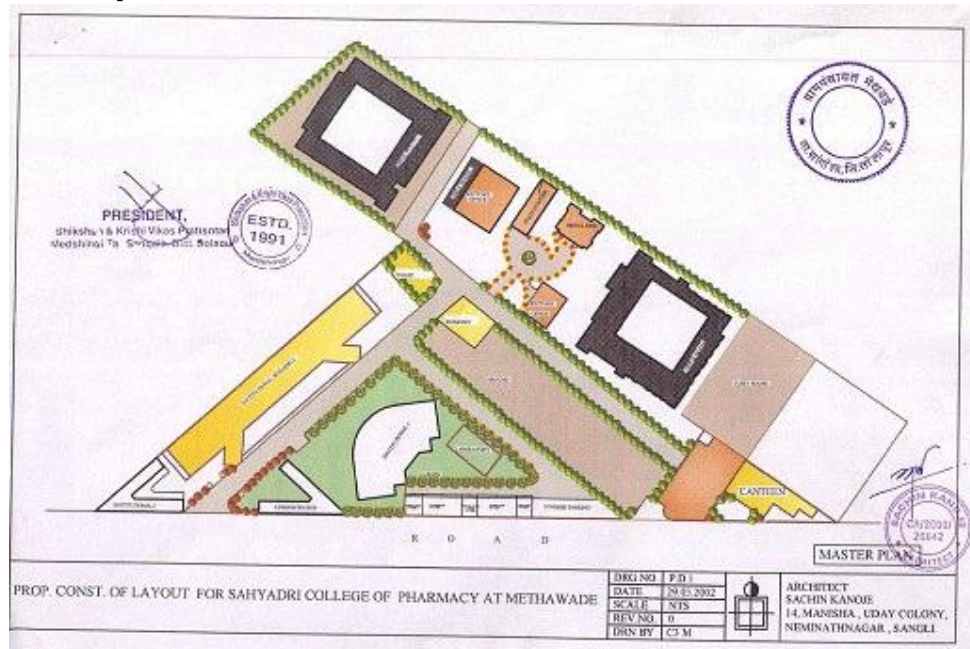

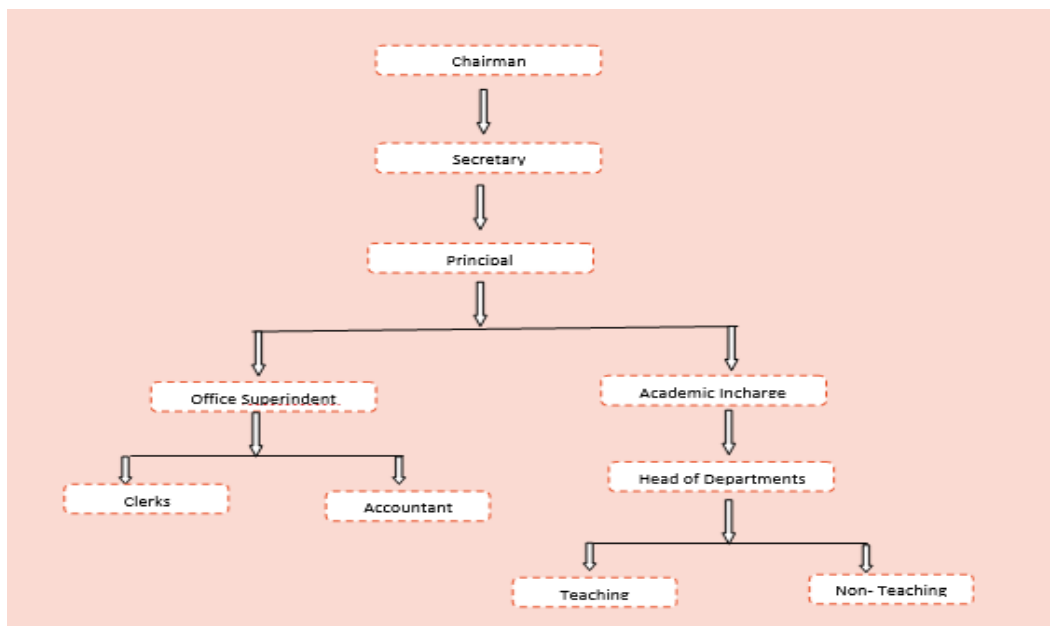

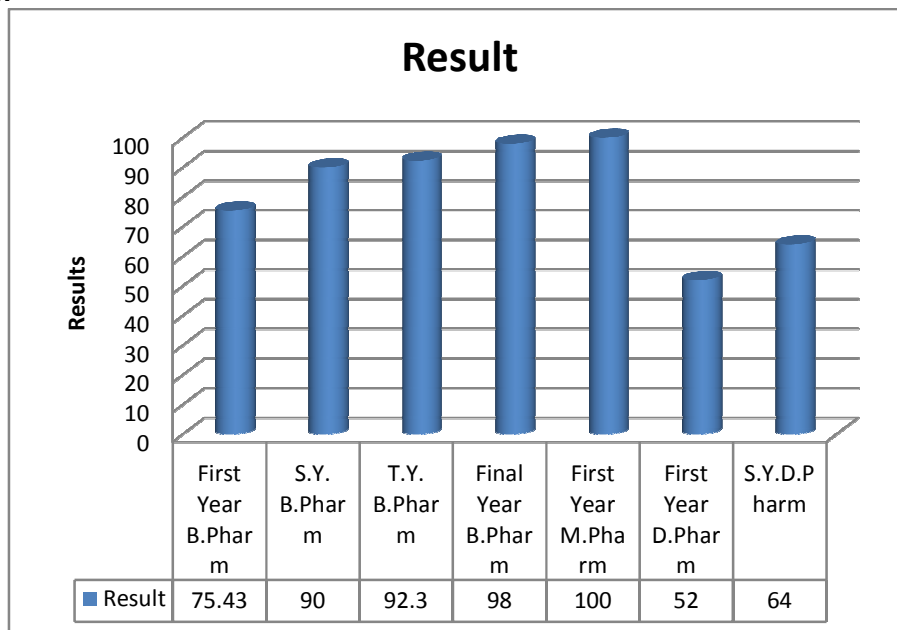

Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics AND Secured minimum **50% marks** i.e. not less than 150 marks out of 300 marks in case of open category and minimum **45% marks** i.e. not less than 135 marks out of 300 marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State in the subjects **Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics** added together (Maximum of marks obtained in Biology/Mathematics shall be considered for the purpose of addition) **AND** Obtained a **non Zero score at MHT-CET. MHT-CET is compulsory for only B.Pharmacy admissions.**

M. Pharm.:

Candidate should be an Indian National and who possess Bachelors degree or equivalent in Pharmacy from an AICTE approved institutions, with at least 55 % marks for open category (at least 50% marks in case of SC/ST category belonging to Maharashtra State only) & should have valid Non zero GPAT Score. The candidate should have registration with State Pharmacy Council. The candidates not having registration should produce the registration certificate within one month after securing admission.
