ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

For D. Pharmacy

i) Passed HSC Science with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the subject Mathematics or Biology (Botany and Zoology) from a recognized institution in Maharashtra State

For B. Pharmacy

Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics AND Secured minimum 45% marks i.e. not less than 135 marks out of 300 marks in case of open category and minimum 40% marks i.e. not less than 120 marks out of 300 marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Mathematics added together (Maximum of marks obtained in Biology/Mathematics shall be considered for the purpose of addition) AND Obtained a non Zero score at MHT-CET or Obtained non Zero positive score at NEET. MHT-CET or NEET is compulsory for only B.Pharmacy admissions.

For Direct Second year B. Pharmacy

(i) The Candidate should be an Indian National; (ii) Passed Diploma Course in Pharmacy with at least 45% marks (at least 40% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) from an All India Council for Technical Education or Pharmacy Council of India or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent.

For M. Pharmacy

Candidate should be an Indian National and who possess Bachelors degree or equivalent in Pharmacy from an AICTE approved institutions, with at least 55 % marks for open category (at least 50% marks in case of SC/ST category belonging to Maharashtra State only) & should have valid Non zero GPAT Score. The candidate should have registration with State Pharmacy Council. The candidates not having registration should produce the registration certificate within one month after securing admission. For sponsored candidates, minimum of two years of full time work experience in a registered firm/ company/industry/ educational and/ or research institute/ any Government Department or Government Autonomous Organization in the relevant field in which admission is being sought.

* Note : Eligibility Criteria may change as per direction of regulatory bodies & government rules.

Refund of fees after cancellation of admission by Institutions.-

(a) The Candidate shall apply online for cancellation and submit duly signed copy of system generated application for cancellation of admission to the institution. Once the candidate submits online request for cancellation, his/her admission shall be treated as cancelled. The Institute shall consider the online request made by Candidate for cancellation as final irrespective of whether he/she has submitted duly signed copy of system generated application to the Institute. Upon such cancellation, the candidate shall lose the claim on the seat and such seat shall become



available for further allotment. The candidate shall then become entitled to and the Institute shall refund the entire fees to the candidate after deduction of Rs.1000/- towards processing charges and return all his/her original documents submitted to the Institute within two days from submission of duly signed copy of system generated application to the Institute;

(b) Notwithstanding clause (a) above, candidate shall not be entitled to any refund of his/her fee except the Security Deposit and Caution Money Deposit if the online cancellation is effected by the candidate after 5.00 p.m. of the cut-off date prescribed by the Competent Authority;

(c) No institution, who has in its possession or custody, of any document in the form of certificates of degree, diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, shall refuse to return such degree, certificate award or other document with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such person does not intend to pursue or avail any facility in such institution. In such cases action shall be taken as per the directives given by the Government from time to time.

(d) The institution shall not entitle to recover the fees for the subsequent years from the student seeking cancellation of his admission at any point of time.

Fee Structure

The fees will be as per Fees regulating authority norms prescribed from time to time. The fees paid by the candidate will be refunded as per rules given in pharmacy CAP brochure.

Attendance

As per university rules attendance is an important factor in Sahyadri College of Pharmacy. During the academic year students are expected to have at least 80% attendance for lectures & 90% attendance for laboratory hours in individual subject.
